


## **TRAVERTINE**

It has a lineal (veincut) or concentric (crosscut) appearance and mainly comes in cream coloured and tan varieties. We also have a new range with darker veins. Travertine is a great choice for flooring and can be used both inside and outside your home.



## **TRAVERTINE**

Travertine is a banded, compact variety of limestone commonly formed along streams, where there are waterfalls or around hot or cold springs. The holes in travertine were created by carbon dioxide bubbles that were trapped when the stone formed. This gives it an open texture that can be filled or left in its natural state.



## **MARBLE & LIMESTONE**

Marble with its inherent warmth, adds a sophisticated element to the area in which it is installed making it a very a popular compliment to modern interiors.

Limestone is a sedimentary rock that has been formed over millions of years at the bottom of lakes and seas. Often limestone can be found with fossils (e.g. Jura limestone which clearly shows the sedimentary nature of the material.) Limestones vary in hardness (density) depending on their age and formation.

The softer limestones are often used for carving of fireplace surrounds and art works. Although not as durable as granite, limestone can be maintained well. Their soft natural beauty and colours are very popular in complimenting our modern interiors.



### **MARBLE & LIMESTONE**


Marble is a metamorphic rock found in the mountainous regions of many countries of the world. Marble quarried in Iran, India, China, Italy, Turkey and Spain represents the majority of marble, in terms of volume, that is utilized worldwide. Because of its beauty and elegance, marble is a popular choice for countertops, floors, foyers, fireplace facings, fire hearths, walls, and windowsills. Many marbles are well suited for wet area application, which extends the versatility of this material to include baths and showers.

The calcite crystal is the basic building block of true marbles. The calcite crystal is vulnerable to attack by mild acids, including those commonly found in kitchen and bar settings, so although not ruled out completley, use for these applications requires more care and maintenance.





You can choose from pastel shades of golden honey, greens, smoky greys and a deep amber. The bands or lines of contrasting color running throughout the stone contribute to its unique characteristics. Similar to marble, onyx can be finished with a polished or honed surface.



# **ONYX**

This natural stone has beautiful, translucent and contrasting colours. The colours of onyx are soft and sensuous, bold and beautiful and work best when used under lighting or back lighting to draw attention to these translucent qualities.



## **PACKING**

Usually suppliers load 22 up to 28 wooden Worthy Wooden Crates& covered by nylon to the 20 Ft containers. The numbers vary due to the size of the crates.





Pine wood should be used in the crates so that you can be sure that you will receive the materials with unbroken crates.
